- EFG reserves the right to review and decide on any exceptional cases at Management's discretion.

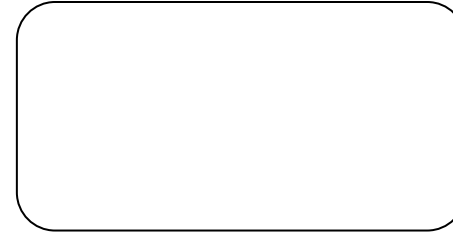
