- EFG reserves the right to review and decide on any exceptional cases at Management's discretion.





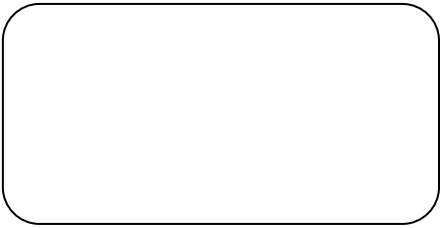

The Workplace Safety and Health (Shipbuilding and Ship-repairing) Regulations 2008 Reg. 6 (2) stipulates that "It shall be the duty of every person not to carry out any work deemed hazardous in a shipyard or on board a ship in a harbor unless he has undergone a safety and health training course approved by the commissioner for Workplace Safety and Health".

Who should attend this course?

All workers are required to work at the shipyards in their daily operations and activities exposing themselves to all kinds of hazards.

Course Objectives

This course is aimed at providing individuals with the requisite shipyard knowledge and skills so as to perform their work activities properly and safely. At the end of the course, participants will be able to:
